Italian Cultural Institute is one of 90 institutions of this kind which promote Italian cultural heritage in its various expressions around the world. The initiatives taken on the one hand show the diversity of the spirit of the Italian reality, while on the other offer the possibility for dialogue between the local and Italian cultural scene.

The Institute has changed several locations since 1940, when it started operating Belgrade. As of July 1, 2006, it is located in the building named Palazzo Italia, at 56 Kneza Miloša Street. This property is owned by the Republic of Serbia and managed by our Company.

With regard to the established and future cooperation, H.E. Carlo Lo Cascio, Ambassador of Italy in Belgrade, and the newly appointed Director of the Italian Cultural Institute, Mr. Roberto Cincotta, visited Dipos and were introduced to our manner of operating. All parties expressed satisfaction with the partnership established so far, which continues in the spirit of Dante Alighieri's saying - "Noi non potemo avere perfetta vita senza amici" (We cannot live a perfect life without friends).

Celebration of the 700th anniversary of the death of this great poet and the father of the Italian language is the ocassion for numerous programs of the Institute this year. On April 14, the exhibition "Hyper-modern Dante" was opened in the premises of the Italian Cultural Institute in Belgrade, with illustrations of Dante's work around the world from the 1983 – 2021 period.









It offers respectable overview of the latest trends in the long history of illustrated depictions of Dante's works and represents a unique opportunity to present to the Serbian public iconographic artistic interpretations inspired by il Sommo Poeta. It is open until May 12, and after the exhibition in Belgrade, it will be shown to the audience in Athens, Prague, Moscow,

CRISIS HAS NOT SIGNIFICANTLY AFFECTED OUR MEMBERS

Ms. Sanja Ivanić, CCIFS Director, introduced the representatives of Dipos to the way in which members adapt to changes during the Covid-19 virus pandemic.

Commenting on the business of French companies in Serbia, Sanja notes:

– As all the other, French companies in Serbia had to adapt the dynamics of their business and synchronize with new operating conditions. So far, the crisis has not dramatically affected their businesses and there have been no mass layoffs in any of the companies. The most noticeable impact is on the operations of Belgrade Airport (VINCI Airports), where, of course, the volume of traffic has significantly decreased, but the VINCI company has continued to improve the airport infrastructure as planned.

We are currently conducting our third survey regarding the impact of coronavirus on the business of our members, and we will learn how to support them better to overcome the crisis, added Ms. Ivanić, announcing new online socializing events.

Emphasizing the importance of bilateral relations between France and Serbia, she also expressed her hopes that live meetings would return to our lives with accelerated vaccination.

In the Netherlands, *Koningsdag* or *King's Day* is celebrated with great excitement on April 27. This national holiday marks the birthday of King Willem-Alexander, who, as the eldest son of the former Dutch Queen Beatrix, ascended the throne after her abdication in 2013. Willem-Alexander is also the first male descendant in the royal family after many princesses who were taking turns over 130 years - actually since 1851.

King's birthday is a non-working day for most residents in all parts of the Netherlands. It is celebrated in many ways including organized events and programs, street sales and wearing orange, the color of this dynasty and the national color.

Bilateral relations between the Netherlands and Serbia

Serbia and the Netherlands have a long history of bilateral relations. After Serbia became independent in 1878, diplomatic relations with the Netherlands were established in 1899.

Recently, Serbia's European path has opened doors to very vivid economic cooperation. Today, Dutch companies employ more than 15,000 people in Serbia. They operate in a number of sectors, from shipbuilding (Vahali), to IT (Levi9), sales, agriculture, beer industry (Heineken) ... In the period from 2010 to 2018, the Netherlands invested in Serbia about 2, 3 billion euros, which makes it one of the largest sources of foreign direct investment. One of the announcements of new ways of cooperation during the coronavirus pandemic is the Dutch national airline KLM, which will be connecting Belgrade and Amsterdam by new direct flights starting in May this year.
