Did you know that Milan Rakic, although remembered as a poet, wrote only about fifty poems in his lifetime and that he spent his entire life as a highly acknowledged Serbian diplomat serving in Skopje, Thessaloniki, Copenhagen, Sofia and Rome?

He took part in the wars for the liberation of Serbia at the beginning of the 20th century. Although his comrades-in-arms often recited his poem "At Gazimestan", only a few actually knew that its author was among them.
