

SERBIAN DIPLOMATS

DJORDJE SIMIC



Djordje Simic was a Serbian politician, twice Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Serbia, and one of the founders of the Serbian Red Cross. He was appointed consul general in Sofia in 1882, and he remained in that position until diplomatic relations with Bulgaria were broken. At the suggestion of Jovan Ristic, he served as the head of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and at the end of 1887, he was appointed as a deputy to the imperial court in Russia.
