On May 29, the Day of Serbian Diplomacy was celebrated in our country in memory of May 29, 1839. On that day, the Prince's Office of Foreign Affairs was founded, which is considered the beginning of professional diplomacy in Serbia. On that occasion, First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Ivica Dacic laid a wreath on the grave of Ivo Andric, who was in the diplomatic service for 21 years, serving in eight countries.

Congratulations on the Day of Serbian Diplomacy

On this day in 1839, the Prince's Office of Foreign Affairs was founded, which is considered the beginning of professional diplomacy in Serbia.

At the time, Avram Petronijevic, personal secretary of Milos Obrenovic, was the head of the Office, and this institution had only 13 officials and a few representative offices: in the Ottoman Empire, Russia, and Austria.

Today, our country has more than 100 diplomatic and consular missions on all continents, which stand for peace and prosperity, and at the service of citizens and the state of Serbia.

Savski venac: the municipality with the greatest number of residential properties in our portfolio

The name of the municipality Savski venac symbolizes its position because like a wreath it is located along the banks of the Sava. It was founded in 1957 and covers an area of 1,580 hectares.

This municipality is home to some of the most important institutions, such as the Government of the Republic of Serbia, most ministries, numerous state institutions, the Palace of Justice, the administrative building of the Serbian Railways, the Clinical and Emergency Center, the Military Medical Academy, the Banknote Production Institute, most of Belgrade's faculties and fifteen primary and secondary schools.

Our gems: Škarka's Villa

The famous, Škarka's Villa a cultural monument and an object of significant architectural and cultural-historical value, in addition to its unique facade, is also adorned with a courtyard of opulent beauty.

It is located at Deligradska Street 13, and today it houses the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus.

It was built in 1926-1927. as a representative city villa, and it was designed by Dragiša Brašovan, one of the leading representatives of Serbian architecture between the two world wars.

This villa, which is managed by Dipos, is one of the few buildings with a romantic spirit and as such has a special place in Belgrade's interwar architecture.
