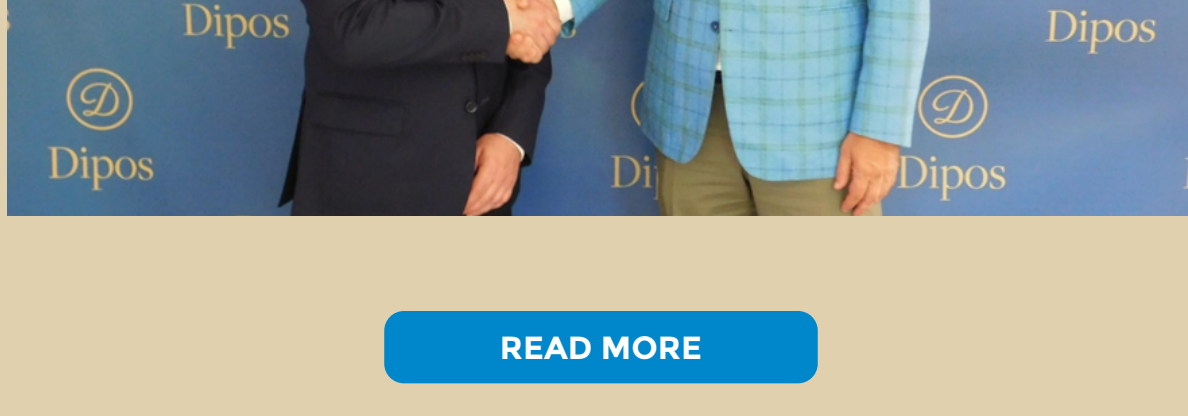
We will introduce you to the life and work of Branislav Nusic, the greatest Serbian comedian and diplomat.

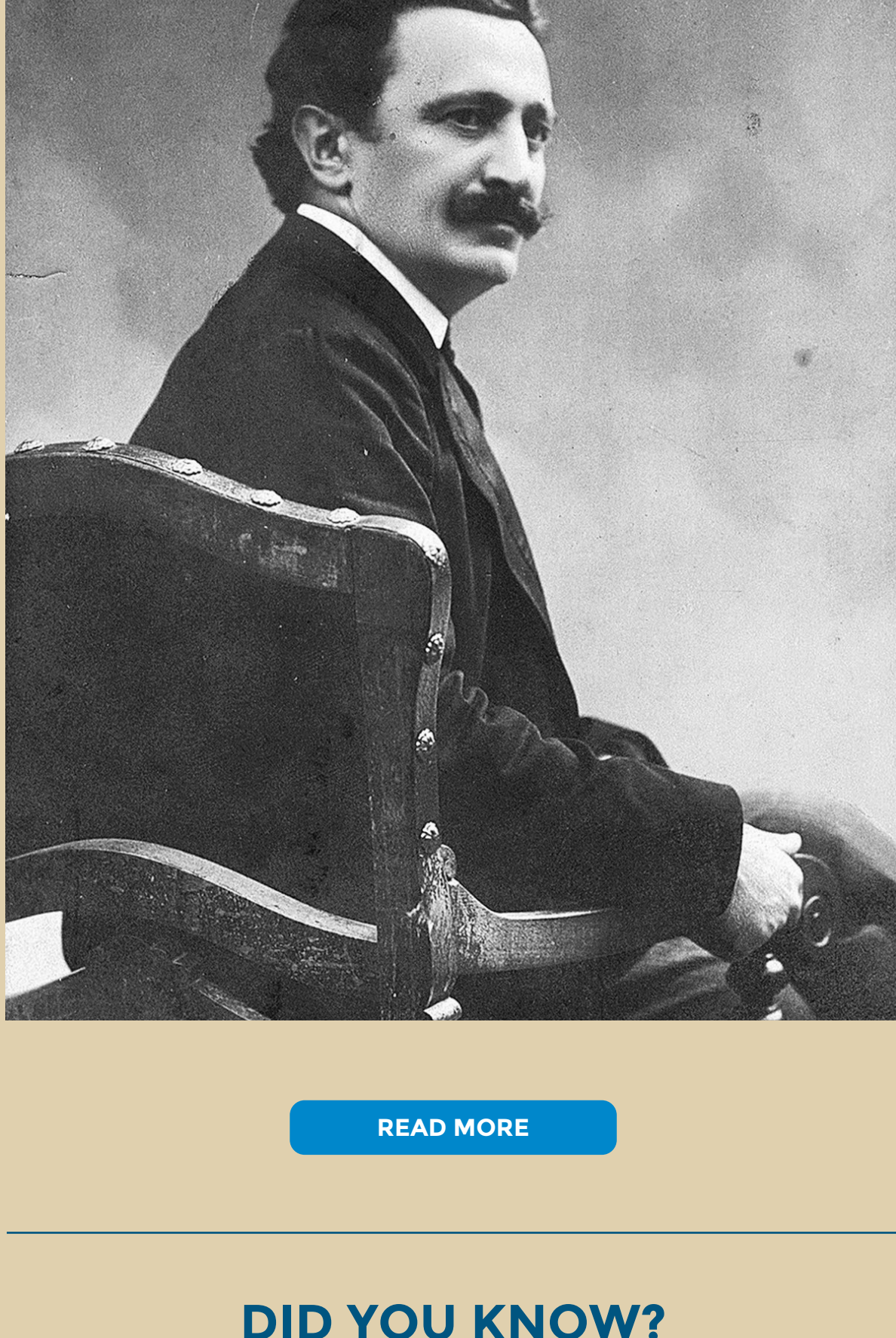

Serbian diplomats

BRANISLAV NUSIC

Although remembered as the greatest Serbian comedian, Branislav Nusic was a politician and vice-consul in the Consulate of the Kingdom of Serbia in Pristina (then Ottoman Empire). He built his diplomatic reputation on great zeal, and his letters to the Royal Government were more studious elaborations than ordinary reports.
